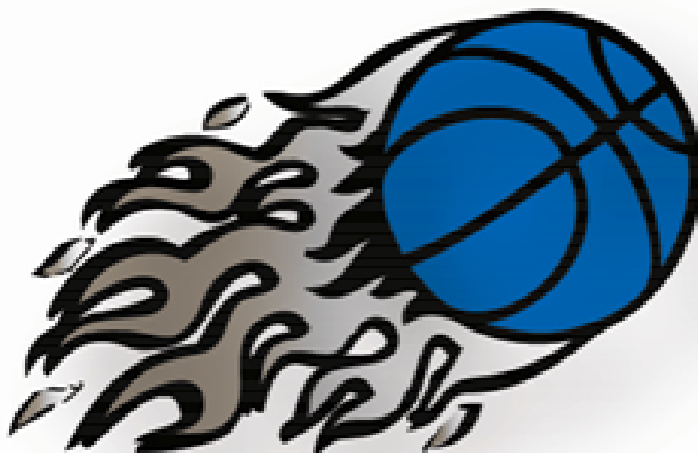

The camp will be held at two locations: Naomi Drenan Recreation Center in Charlotte, NC and Albemarle Road Recreation Center in Mint Hill, NC from June 14, 2010 through August 20, 2010. Camp will begin at 8:00am and end at 4:30pm. Each weekly session is \$80.00 and there is a one-time \$50.00 registration fee. Before and after camp care is available from 7:30am – 6:00pm. 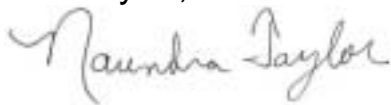

SUMMER BASKETBALL CAMP SCHEDULE

Campers will meet at the Recreation Center at 8:00a.m. Please do not drop off your child before 8:00a.m. unless he/she is enrolled in before camp care. If for some reason your child is going to be late or must leave early, please let us know in advance. Campers will not be permitted to leave early without prior arrangements or in the case of an emergency. Campers should be picked up promptly at 4:30p.m. and no later than 6:00p.m. unless your child is enrolled in after camp care.

Our basketball camps are for boys and girls ages 5 - 15 and have the unique focus of teaching basic fundamentals and various drills and techniques. Campers learn basketball handling skills through intensive ball control drills and then build on their superior ball-handling skills by learning quick moves off the dribble. Each camp session provides a mix of physical activity, practice, instruction, life skills, and fun! There are indoor and outdoor activities. A daily snack and lunch are provided to all campers. There are special guest appearances from Division I Players, Semi-Professional Players and Professional Players.

The basketball camps will be operated by certified coaches and all coaches have background clearances. The camps are insured and will begin Monday, June 14, 2010 and end on Friday, August 20, 2010. The camp hours are from 8:00a.m. to 4:30p.m., Monday through Friday. Campers will be provided a snack at 9:00a.m. and picnic style lunch at 12:00p.m. and will receive a camp t-shirt. Queen City Prep will be responsible for the registration of all campers. The Recreation Center will have the gymnasium and outdoor courts available for use during the ten-week summer basketball camp. The staff to camper ratio will be 1:10. We are expecting to register approximately 50 participants during the summer basketball camp.
